Whitewater State Park

Whitewater State Park offers 6 miles of groomed trails in a beautiful valley setting 30 minutes west of Winona. The trails are rated beginner and are easily reached from the Visitor Center which has a fireplace and rest rooms.

Perrot State Park

Located in a well-known wildlife habitat, Perrot State Park has varied terrain and a wilderness atmosphere. The Mississippi River is the park's western boundary. Begin skiing near the campground. There are 8.5 miles of well marked trails with one shelter stop at trailside.

How to find State Parks

1. Whitewater State Park

19041 Hwy. 74, Altura, MN 55910. 507-932-3007.
 From Winona take Hwy. 14 west about 22 miles to St. Charles. At St. Charles, turn north (right) onto Hwy. 74. Follow Hwy. 74 about 9 miles to the Visitor Center.

2. Perrot State Park

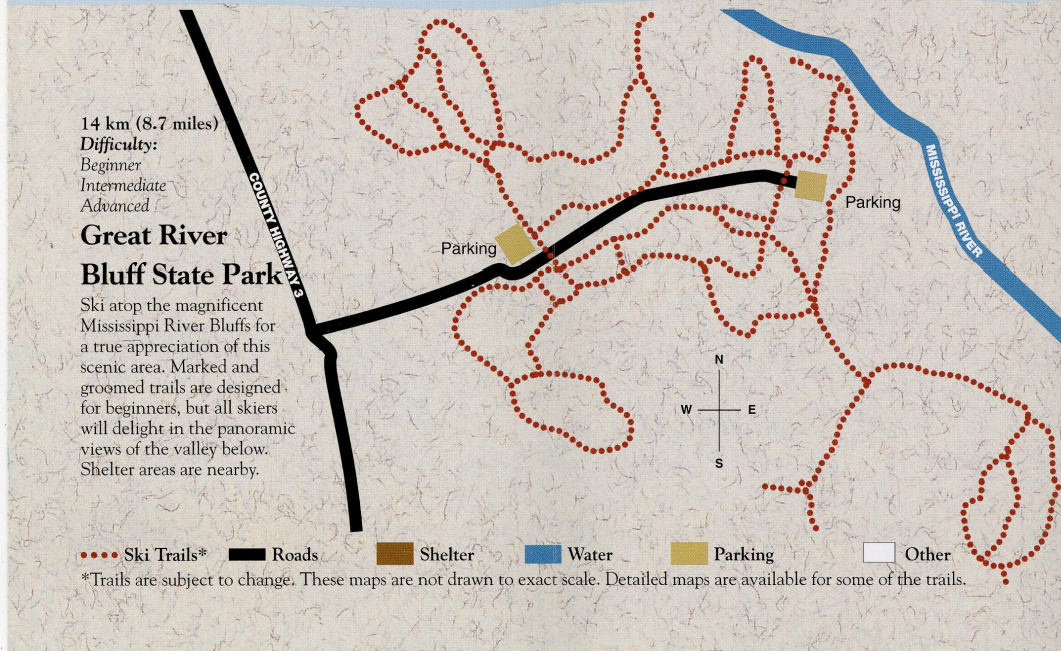

 Take Hwy 43 across the bridge to Wisc. Hwy. 35. Turn right (south) and follow 35 to Centerville. Turn right to stay on 35 to Trempealeau, then follow signs to the park.

3. Great River Bluff State Park

43605 Kipp Dr., Winona, Minnesota 55987. 507-643-6849.
 From Winona take Hwy. 61 south about 10.5 miles to County Rd. 3. Turn west (right) onto 3 and watch for signs to the park. Or, from I-90 take exit 266 north onto Hwy. 43 and turn right quickly onto County 12. Follow 12 to County Rd. 3, then follow signs to the park.

Ski Passes and Use Permits

A State Ski Pass is required on Minnesota State funded trails for people ages 16 to 64. Purchase Passes at the Park Office or by calling: 1-800-766-6000. Wisconsin State trails require a trail permit. For people 16 and older, when groomed. Check with the Park Manager.
