



Bluffside Park contains 15 miles of multi-use trails, which provide picturesque views of the Mississippi River valley from atop the bluffs. Trails may be used for mountain biking, hiking, skiing, and snowshoeing and vary in difficulty. Download the Avenza Maps App and get the Bluffside Park right on your phone! SUGAR LOAF PARK



Sugar Loaf is a regional destination for beginner and intermediate hiking and snowshoeing. There are also bolted routes for rock climbing on Sugar Loaf and in the winter we have one of the largest human made ice climbing parks in the nation.

PRAIRIE ISLAND PARK



Located on the banks of the Mississippi, Prairie Island has a 1.5 mile trail winding through the riverbed forest ideal for hiking. The park also contains public boat landings, dog park, wildlife viewing, fishing, playground, volleyball and horseshoe pits, and camping adjacent at Prairie Island Campground.
