

FUN and FREE Things to do in WINONA, MN

- Drive up or hike up to Garvin Heights Lookout for a breathtaking view of Winona and the river valley – you can see about 18 miles up and down the river on a clear day.
- 2. Stop and smell the roses at the Rose Gardens along Lake Park Drive.
- 3. The Veterans Memorial Park is a great place to learn about the wars our veterans fought in.
- 4. Take in Concerts at the Lake Park Bandshell on Wednesday nights in the summer at 8 p.m.
- 5. Admire the classic cars that gather at Lakeview Drive Inn during their summer Cruise Nights.
- Walk/run/bicycle/rollerblade/skate on the paths around the lakes and various trails. West Lake path is 1.81 miles; East Lake path is 3.7 miles. Dogs allowed on West Lake path only.
- 7. Learn more about local products at the Winona Farmers' Market on Saturdays 7:30 a.m. -
- 12:00 p.m. in downtown Winona at Levee Park, May-Oct., and occasional indoor winter markets.
- 8. Walk Winona's historic downtown and admire the architectural styles and stained glass.
- 9. Walk along Levee Park and watch the towboats and barges go by.
- 10. Stop at Windom Park and admire the Princess Wenonah statue, fountain, gazebo and garden.
- 11. Fish the lakes or the **Mississippi River** and streams in our area.
- 12. Learn about the J. R. Watkins Company at the Watkins Heritage Museum & Store.
- 13. Hike the **Prairie Island Nature Trail**, or the expansive **Bluffside Park Trails** featuring 15+ miles of maintained hiking and mountain biking trails.
- 14. The Willows Disc Golf Course is located around east Lake Winona, The Woods at Saint Mary's University, and the Prairie Island Disc Golf Course. Get maps at the Visitor Center.
- 15. Surprise the kids with a visit to the **African Safari Exhibit** on the third floor of WNB Financial downtown. It's wild!
- 16. Check out some books or movies from the Winona Public Library. Adult and Youth activities and programs are available year round.
- 17. If you're an art enthusiast, you can view the wonderful art collection in the **Winona State**University library as well as changing exhibits at the **Watkins Gallery**. The university also has a "Garden & Monument Tour" that you can experience. Saint Mary's University has the Lillian Davis Hogan Galleries at the Toner Student Center, and the **Winona Arts Center** gallery downtown exhibit local and regional artists.
- 18. View the Mississippi River as you never have before. The Interstate Bridge features a 12-foot wide pedestrian biking/walking path with scenic overlooks in the middle of the river.
- 19. Once across the Mississippi, visit Latsch Island Park and beach, and take a stroll over the wagon bridge. You'll get a peek at our unique boat house community and continue onto the new Flyway Trail Winona Connector, a pedestrian trail leading into the Wisconsin trail system. If you're a bird-watcher, bring your binoculars.
- 20. Take a dip in the Mississippi at the Michael LaCanne Memorial Park in nearby Goodview, featuring a swimming beach, fishing pier, boat launch, playground equipment, soccer fields, a paved walking/bike path (2.04 miles), and restrooms.
- 21. Hiking trails along its newly-updated front side of **Sugar Loaf Bluff** offer adventure seekers a unique vantage point to see the city. Parking is available on Lake Boulevard; trailhead is behind the Edina Realty parking lot.
